What were some fears/hesitations you had about going solar?

"Some of my fears about going to solar were the pricing as well as whether or not our house was located in the right area to soak up the sun. I like to work from a monthly budget and with the drastic changes in our bill from season to season, it was not easy to stay on track financially."

What has been your biggest benefit of going solar that you've personally seen?

"We've had our solar installed for about 8 months now and so far, the biggest benefit has been the lower electricity bills. We're hardly paying anything for electricity each month and hopefully, at the end of year one, we look to even be owed money from our electric company!"

What was your electric bill before you decided to go solar?
